



Walk 13: Daisy Bank and Barton House ruin.

1.8 miles

Mainly an urban walk but including a nature reserve and an ancient historic ruin.



Route

These directions start at the pedestrian crossing lights on Audlett Drive.

- Enter the footpath signposted Daisy Bank.
- Follow the Daisy Bank path to the end passing behind three school playing fields.
- At the end of the path you reach the end of Hadland Road. Look ahead and you will see the entry to the Earth Trust, Abby Fishpond nature reserve (also known as Daisy Bank)
- Follow the path and turn right just before the bridge.
- Follow the path which takes you to Audlet Drive and turn right.
- Take the first right into Nyatt Road (Opposite the leisure centre).
- Turn left at Hadland Road and then left at Reade Road.
- Turn right into Lee Avenue and at the end enter Herman Close and turn left immediately into the passageway (just after the smiling clock!).
- Leaving the passage, turn right and follow the road to Curtis Avenue where you turn right and then turn right into Sherwood Avenue.
- When you reach the green play area, bear left crossing the area diagonally. Admire the remains of Barton House which is in the middle of the green area.
- Leaving the opposite corner of the green area, you will re-enter the Daisy Bank path where you turn left and get back to the start.
